N118/114 – Proposal for new night bus service route N118 and permanent withdrawal of weekend night bus service, route 114 (currently suspended) – 19 May to 29 June 2025

What you told us

The proposals for the N118 were widely supported, while responses to the proposal for closure of the 114 were mixed.



90%

thought the new N118 would have a positive impact

You supported the proposed new N118 night bus route because it was seen as helping those who need to travel to or from work during night-time. You also thought it would enable affordable, safe night-time transport for both work and socialising (nightlife) in London.



33%

of respondents were negative about the 114 closure, while the same proportion were neutral

You liked the new night-time connections to Ruislip, Sudbury, South Harrow and surrounding areas that the new N118 service would offer.



21%

were positive about the 114 closure

You did have concerns about increased (24-hour) noise and pollution from the N118 proposals.

You said that if the 114 night service had to be withdrawn permanently you would prefer it if route N118 was being introduced as well.

What we are doing

Thanks to your feedback, we've decided to go ahead with the new N118 night bus route as planned.

We expect N118 to launch in early 2026. Both routes N18 and N118 will run every 30 minutes on weeknights and every 15 minutes on weekend nights. This will offer a combined frequency of every 7-8 minutes between Trafalgar Square and Sudbury & Harrow Road station.

We're also going ahead with plans to permanently withdraw the weekend-only night bus service portion of the 114 bus route, which is already suspended.

The daytime service on the 114 bus route will continue as usual and will not be affected by this withdrawal.
