Lidl GB has unveiled revised plans for a new community foodstore on Ickenham Road, Ruislip.

Following a planning application last year, Lidl has carefully reviewed community feedback and updated the proposals for the former Orchard pub site. This includes enhancing the store design and look, as well as increasing green space and tree retention across the site.

The proposals

A new Lidl foodstore at this site will increase access to our high quality and affordable products, bring this site into full use to serve the community, and create up to 40 new jobs.



A bespoke Lidl store with gabled roofs and red brickwork and detailing to complement the surrounding area. Modern in-store facilities are included like our popular bakery and a 1,224m² sales area offering our full range of products



61 customer parking spaces including accessible, parent & child, two EV chargers (with capacity for more) and cycle parking. Site access arrangements have been revised for pedestrian and vehicle safety



Enhanced landscaping proposals with tree planting and retention across the site. The store has been pushed back within the site to further protect key views from Ickenham Road



An improved memorial garden with additional tree retention and seating area. This package, including a Spitfire memorial, will enhance this space for the local community



Up to 40 jobs for local people, including full and part-time roles. Lidl GB pay rate for hourly paid colleagues is a minimum of £14.80 per hour, increasing to £15.30 with length of service



Lidl has an ongoing commitment to enhance the environmental sustainability of its stores. A range of technology is used in-store to minimise energy use, such as heat recovery systems and air source heat pumps. Solar panels on the roof would provide up to 25% of the store's energy requirements
